The 2022 Salzburg Festival: First Ticket Order Deadline 24 January

(SF, 21 January 2022) The two centenary editions of the Festival are followed in 2022 by a thematic focus on Dante Alighieri's *Divine Comedy*, the *Divina Commedia*. In various versions and realities, the motifs of heaven, hell and purgatory can be found throughout this year's Salzburg Festival programme.

Initial reactions to the programme announcement have sparked confidence and raised hopes for a summer resembling pre-pandemic times. For 174 performances within 45 days at 17 venues, plus 54 performances within the youth programme "jung & jede*r", a total of 224,933 tickets have been issued.

Monday, 24 January 2022 is the first deadline for ticket orders for the 2022 Salzburg Festival. Orders received before this deadline have a higher chance of being filled as requested. All requests received after 24 January will be filled in the order they were received. Responses as to which tickets can be purchased as requested will be sent out by early April.

On **7 April 2022**, **direct individual sales** begin for those tickets still available, which can then be purchased via our website, www.salzburgerfestspiele.at.

The Salzburg Festival takes place from **18 July to 31 August 2022**.

Festival tickets are available in price categories ranging from 5 € to 455 €, with half of all tickets priced between 5 € and 110 €. All tickets must be personalized and can be ordered as e-tickets

or print@home tickets. Of course, personalization can be changed at any time online without charge.

Once again, there will be **6,000 tickets** available at discounts of up to 90% **for young people** and young adults for opera, drama and concert performances. Details will be available from mid-May at www.salzburgerfestspiele.at/jung-jeder.
